**MIRACULOUS MEDAL NOVENA**

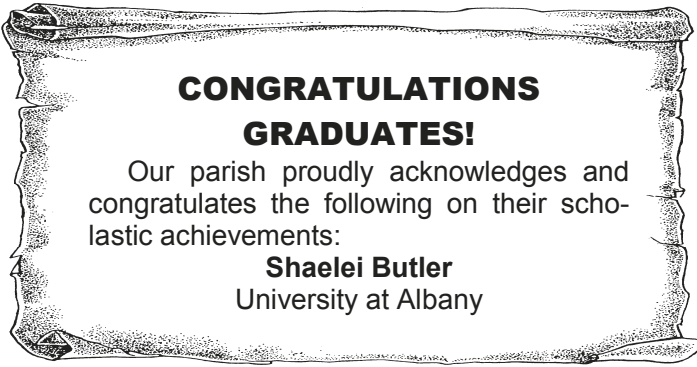
