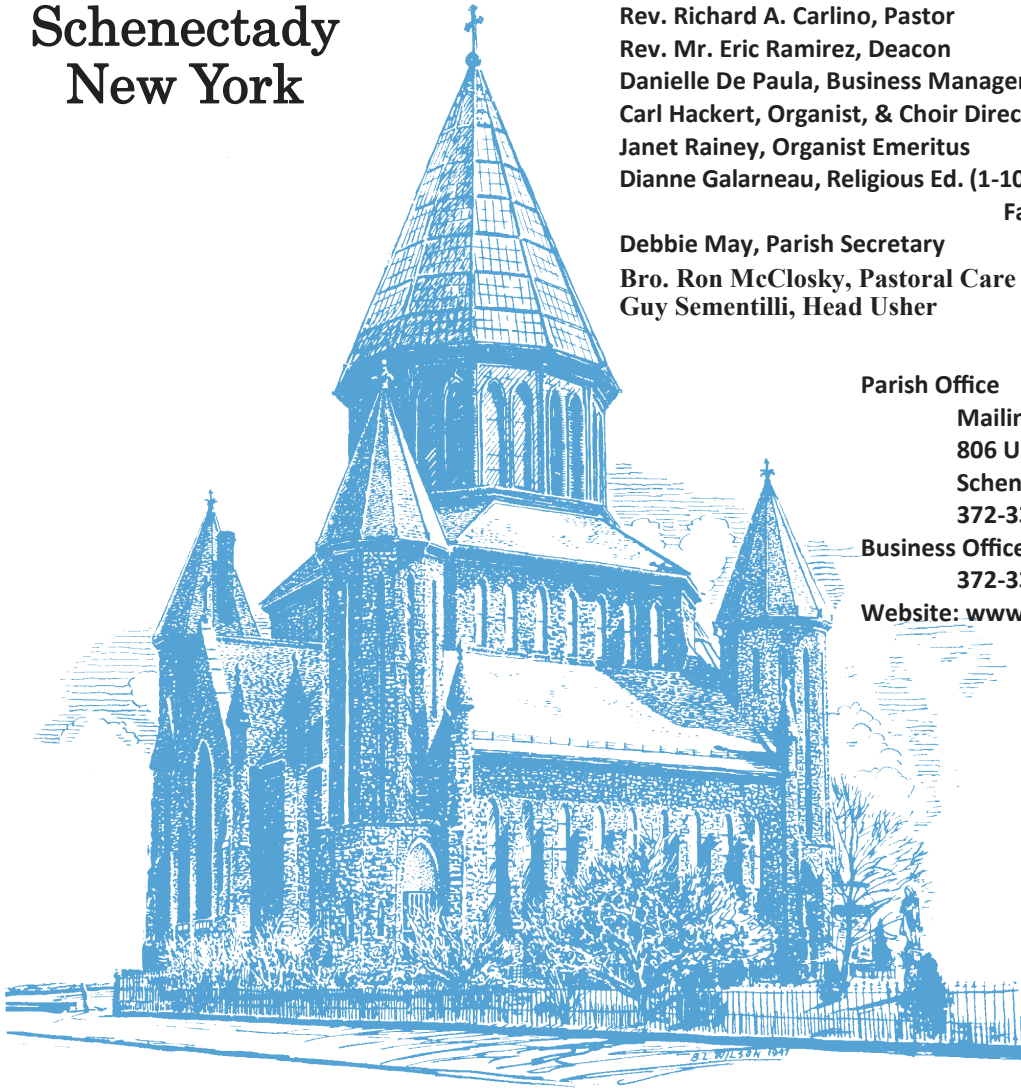

Father God, the star that led the Magi to the stable announced to the world that its Savior was born. Today we live in a world that is still covered by dark-

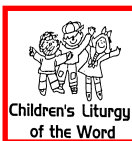
