


Therefore, I invite you to a Prayer Rally for World Peace, on Saturday, October 4, beginning at 11 am, Schenectady Central Park, at the Philippines War Memorial (the statue of the Guardsman holding the rifle), on Monument Hill overlooking the pond. In case of inclement weather, the event held the following We'll begin with the Rosary for World Peace, specifically focusing on the Joyful Mysteries, which include prayers for peace offered by several Popes. The Rosary is a Catholic prayer- a beautiful, inspiring meditation on the life of Christ. 
